Every 3 days a woman is killed as a result of domestic violence in the UK.

1 in 3 women in the UK will experience abuse in their lifetime.

1 in 4 children and young people experienced physical abuse over the year.

1 in 4 women have been raped or sexually assaulted as an adult.

53% of trans people aged 18 to 24 have experienced a hate crime or incident based on their gender identity in the last 12 months.

1 in 20 children aged 11-17 in the UK have been sexually abused.

There were more than 10,000 stalking offences recorded in London in the 12 months leading up to September 2021.

This has to stop.
