# Up to 12 weeks of free, confidential & practical support for female survivors with no current sexual violence case open with the police, CPS or courts.

This is a new service at North London Rape Crisis and has been designed to support survivors of sexual violence who do not currently have an open sexual violence case; either the case has closed or you do not want to report to the police.

The service offers short term direct support, as well as referrals for longer term support, to survivors who have practical support needs in areas such as housing, benefits, immigration, health, work, education, children, financial concerns etc.

## Eligibility criteria

- Female (trans and cisgender) survivors of sexual violence who experienced the violence at any point in their lives
- Aged 13+
- At least one practical support need
- No active domestic violence
