The Amari Project provides supported accommodation to some of the most marginalised women in London who have exited sex work or a survivor or victim of sexual exploitation or trafficking

The second stage accommodation consists of shared living within a purpose-built house leased by London and Quadrant Housing Association.

Amari is available to women who:

- Have exited sex working or trafficking
- Aged 18+
- Single or with a child under 2
- Have access to public funds
- Have been living successfully in first stage accommodation
- Committed to working towards settling into more permanent, long-term housing
- Have a proven willingness to engage with support, including employment, education or training programmes



Referral Process

- Must be from agencies
- Require consent from the woman who will undergo a face to face assessment
- Contact via email to request a referral form
